Student Housing & Security for Homeless Students **Senator Espinosa** possible meeting with Assistant Director of Housing Tuesday, need to establish priorities; housing for the students in immediate need, establishing a plan for future students in need, research other college campus emergency housing programs, Housing wants to be involved with the resolution, possibility of Ad Hoc committee to help with research and resolution
