Gender Neutral Restrooms – I. Ramirez II. Resolution is in the works. S. Simonds reminded us that because Thursday's influence the time documents are sent to Senate, we need to hit hard with referrals. Deadline for resolution: March 17, 2016 Ramirez caught up her guests on the occurrences of gender inclusive restrooms L. Vincent claims the cheapest way to install these restrooms is just to change the signs. Ken Rosenthal discusses the new gender inclusive restrooms that is being implemented in SH. However, funding is always an issue when implementing these restrooms, they cost \$80,000. S. Simonds expresses the idea of changing single stall restrooms into inclusive restrooms. Gender Inclusive restrooms are on the 5-year plan, but a model is in the works. III. Enhancing Accessibility on Campus - I. Ramirez Visit from Ken Rosenthal. Demonstration courtesy from Leanne Vincent. Ken Rosenthal mentions how codes have changed over time, so accessibility issues are different. Our campus is the most ADA friendly. Ken Rosenthal and his projects do not fund restrooms in the USU. There are definitely plans to enhance our campus. Both this referral and gender inclusive restrooms are on a top priority. C.
